

## AP Latin Summer 2017

Over the summer you will be continuing the translation and preparing for the translations and analyses of Caesar's *Commentarii de Bello Gallico* and Vergil's the *Aeneid*. You have all ready begun the study of Caesar's commentaries.

Over summer there will be a google sheet provided with a schedule of any updates to assignments.

You will continue to review the Caesar and Vergil vocabulary list during the summer, and first semester you will continue vocabulary quizzes.

### **Assignments and due dates:**

Finish reading the English translation of Caesar's commentaries (<http://classics.mit.edu/Caesar/gallic.html>). For each chapter, write a 2-3 sentence summary of what you read—a recap—as well as 1 reading comprehension question.

Due June 30, 2017

Scansion Review: see document provided online. You can print and take a picture of your scansion or type it up as dactyl, spondee. This is up to you. For example: dactyl, dactyl, spondee, spondee, dactyl, spondee.

Due July 10, 2017.

Vergil writing assignment: Research the life and death of Vergil, the author of the epic poem the *Aeneid*. In your writing assignment, discuss his early life, works, and his later life including his death. When you discuss his works, include his writing style, and give special attention to the *Aeneid*.

Length: 2-3 pages, double spaced, 1-inch margins, MLA format

Due July 17, 2017.

Vergil Readings: read your English text of the *Aeneid* books 1, 2, and 4, and respond to the reading comprehension questions posted online.

Due July 31, 2017.

Caesar translations 1 and 2: I will provide you the Latin passage online, and you will write out an English translation.

Translation 1 due July 24, 2017.

Translation 2 due first day of class.
